Observation

Focused on local services (school, health care, firemen...)	No other initiative about economic activity development
Focused on tourism (Renovation of the castle; camping site;	Not very busy life on the street (few restaurants, pubs, bakery,...)
Develop culture (Chapel renovation; renovation of cultural house; football courts)	We can't see the linkage with the community
Improvement of agricultural production (Biogas plant; farm renovation)	
Invest in future generation (school...)

Examples:

- Tourism House (restaurant, camp...) **Běšiny**
- Cycling path **Bolešiny**

Suggestions

Economic Development → Tourism field

- ▶ Adventure park
- ▶ Disc golf, mini golf
- ▶ Foto-tourism
- ▶ Camping sites
- ▶ Rental houses (with sauna, accommodation; wellness) log-house
- ▶ Go-cars
- ▶ Sightseeing (castle tour by bikes)
- ▶ Winter tourism (hiking with snow-shoes; snow-tubing; motor-slades;)
- ▶ Paintball
- ▶ Skate park, long board (Scooter downhill (koloběžka)
- ▶ Small zoo farm (wild and/or exotic animals) (study-trips for local school children)

Suggestions

Co-operation

- ▶ Inter-municipal sharing of different meanings (e.g. snow removing facilities, cultural house renting, machinery sharing between farmers etc.)
- ▶ Re-cycling market promoting the aspect of solidarity (e.g. exchange of still functional things, probably after grown-up children, etc.)
- ▶ Build and support the village patriotism (musicians, politicians, etc.)

Suggestions

Improve quality of life

- ▶ Youth centre (place for youth to meet and arrange activities for young people; participating in local life)
- ▶ Study trips to different regions (also abroad)
- ▶ “Gold Autumn” project to improve understanding between generations
- ▶ Awarding local people for their effort to local development
